2-AM Class

- Triple C Nursery School is a preschool program for children ages 2 to 5. We have a 2-AM program for children who are age 3 by August 31. Our purpose is to help children to develop their God-given potential in a loving and caring environment.
- Each day incorporates a variety of experiences for the young child. A free choice period offers learning and playing experiences in the following categories:
 - Dramatic Play
 - Manipulatives (puzzles, games and toys)
 - Language/Listening/Letters
 - Art
 - God's Wonders (science)
 - Sand and Water Tables
 - Flannel Boards
 - Blocks

Group time involves opening circle time, music, gym, snack, art, Bible time, stories, games and special projects.

- Parents take turns providing snacks. We encourage healthy snacks, with special treats on birthdays and holidays.
- There is a Parent Helper Program in which parents may volunteer to help with class projects and other special activities.
- Parent/Teacher conferences are offered during the school year.
- For Christmas, we have a special program when parents, grandparents and siblings are invited to come.
- A year-end Carnival, with family invited, concludes the school year for the 2-AM classes.
- We also offer a program for children ages 2 and young 3 (On My Own), a 3-AM program for children who are 4 by August 31, and a Pre-K program for children who are 5 by October 31 (with Director's approval).
- Annual tuition for the 2-AM class is \$1200, payable in 10 monthly installments of \$120. Tuition is due the first of each month. **The first installment will be due August 1.**
- There is a \$40 **non-refundable** registration fee and a \$25 activity fee payable when you submit your application for enrollment. **Please return the goldenrod application and pink personal information form as soon as possible.** Upon receipt we will confirm your enrollment. An emergency form will be sent to you during the summer to be returned before school begins. The white medical form is also needed before the start of school. You may return it after your child's next visit or simply take it into the office (no appointment necessary) to be signed.
