On My Own

On My Own is an introductory nursery school program for children who are two-years-old by August 31st. The purpose of this program is to provide young preschoolers the opportunity to learn and play in a semi-structured environment that prepares them to attend our 2-AM program the following school year.

Each class period offers activities such as free play, crafts, music and finger plays, circle time, Bible stories, and snack. The children will also visit the playground or gym.

This class is on Wednesday and Friday or Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9:30am to 11:00am. Class size is limited to 12 with a Head Teacher and an Assistant Teacher.

2-AM Classes

Our 2-AM class is a nursery school program for children who are three-years-old by August 31st. Children gain an awareness of God's world and themselves and learn to become part of a group. The daily program consists of free play and group time activities including circle time, gym, snack, art, music, stories, Bible verses and games. Each month has a different emphasis.

Families are invited to the annual Christmas Program, Valentine's Party and the End-of-Year Carnival. Parents are given regular opportunities to participate in the class program.

Parent conferences are offered twice a year.

All classes are held Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9:15am to 11:30am. Class size is limited to 18 with a Head Teacher and Assistant Teacher.

3-AM Classes

The 3-AM program is designed for children who are four-years-old by August 31st. Emphasis is on socialization and school readiness. Most children will go to kindergarten the following year. Children become aware of God's love and care for them and learn to love each other. Monthly themes are enhanced by seasonal activities, classroom visitors and book projects. The daily schedule allows for free choice and group time.

Families are invited to attend the annual Thanksgiving Program, the Valentine Party and the Closing Program. We welcome parents as classroom visitors and helpers.

Parent conferences are offered in November and March.

All classes are held Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings from 9:15am-11:45am. Class size is limited to 20 with a Head Teacher and an Assistant Teacher.

Lunchtime Adventures, an extended school day program, is available Wednesdays from 11:45am-1:45pm for students who are enrolled in our 3-AM and Pre-K programs. We also offer a similar program for our 2-AM students on certain Thursdays from 11:30am - 1:30pm. There is a varied theme each week ranging from crafts, music, sports and literacy connections. Pre-registration is required. Class size is limited to 20 on a first-come, first-served basis.

Pre-K Class

We have a 4-day Pre-K class for children who are five-years-old by August 31st. The Pre-Kindergarten class is designed for children who are age ready for kindergarten but who would benefit from waiting a year before starting formal schooling. However, children who are 5 by November 30th may be admitted **with the Director's approval**.

Pre-K meets Monday through Thursday mornings from 9:15am-11:45am.
